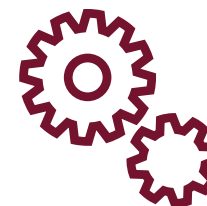

Our school offers various programs to encourage strong leadership skills, positive relationships, peer support and healthy, active lifestyles. Some of our programs include:

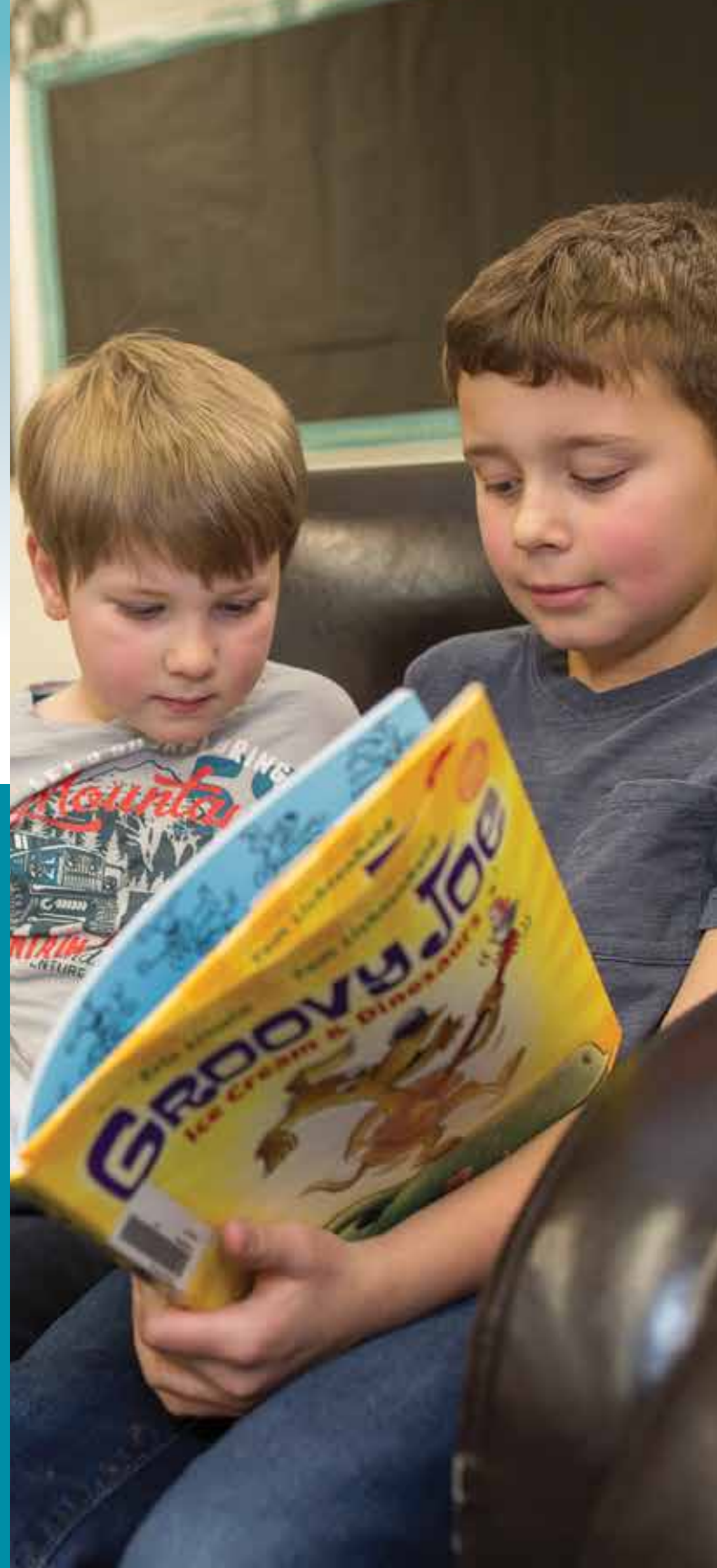

PROGRAMS

Our exciting, engaging programs suit every student's ability, interests and goals!

ALBERTA CURRICULUM

Landing Trail School follows the Alberta Curriculum, which specifies the knowledge and skills that students are expected to learn, set by Alberta Education.

HEADSTART

Headstart is designed for children between the ages of 2½ to 5 who need communication and/or developmental support. Children get a jumpstart on their education, building skills in communication, social development, physical development and emotional development. Screening is required.

KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten students are packed with passion and potential to be anything they want in the world. We work hand-in-hand with parents, offering alternate full day programming to prepare each learner for the transition from home to school and entry into Grade 1.

LOGOS

Offered to students from kindergarten to Grade 4, the LOGOS Program allows children to achieve their full academic potential in a non-denominational, Christian environment based on Biblical principles and God's word. Children remain involved in school-wide events, programs and other activities.

LEADERSHIP

Offered to Grade 4 students who wish to take on a leadership role in the school. Activities include planning assembly themes, announcing morning safety messages and participating in a service project.

MUSIC

Our award-winning music program provides students with the opportunity to develop an appreciation for music and learn to experiment with a variety of different instruments.



NUTRITION

Landing Trail School offers a hot lunch program and through donations and grants, is also able to provide a small selection of healthy breakfast, lunch and snack items for children who need them. Through proper nutrition and daily physical activities, the nutrition program encourages alert minds, good health and overall wellness among students.

PROGRAM UNIT FUNDING

PUF provides assistance for students between the ages of 2½ and 5 years who have a diagnosed need in one or more areas (speech and language, behaviour and fine or gross motor skills). PUF children are fully included in preschools and kindergarten, as well as supported at home, to help your child reach his/her potential.
